# Community Impact Story

## Serving When Seconds Matter

On October 19, 2025, a medical emergency in Cherry Hills Village underscored the critical role the Police Department plays when seconds matter most.

Officer Belding responded to a call that became part of a life-saving chain of events. Upon arrival, he supported ongoing CPR efforts and remained engaged until the patient was transported to the hospital for further care.

Weeks later, the patient reunited with those who helped that day. In reflecting on the experience, he shared words that resonated deeply within the community:

*"It has become clear to me that your work is truly an underlying fabric of our community. Your presence here today exemplifies the true heart and soul of our city."*

Moments like this reinforce the importance of ensuring officers have the training, equipment, and support they need to respond when it matters most. Through donor and community support, the Foundation helps make that possible.

Investing in the K-9 Program: Shadow and Tuco

In 2025, the Cherry Hills Village Police Foundation funded the purchase of K-9 Shadow, representing a significant investment in public safety.

This purchase was made possible through a generous donation from a Cherry Hills Village resident, reflecting the strong support and trust the community places in the Police Department and the Foundation's mission.

K-9 Shadow joins K-9 Tuco, who was added to the Department in 2024 through Foundation funding made possible by a generous local family foundation. Together, Shadow and Tuco represent the Foundation's ongoing commitment to strengthening the Department's K-9 program through thoughtful, community-supported investment.

Police K-9s play a critical role in law enforcement, assisting with suspect apprehension, tracking, detection, and community engagement. Acquiring and training K-9s represents a long-term operational and financial commitment.

By supporting the addition of both K-9 Shadow and K-9 Tuco, the Foundation has helped ensure the Department has the resources needed to respond effectively and safely. Both dogs have already become valued members of the Department and beloved ambassadors within the Cherry Hills Village community.

## ■ How the Foundation Operates

- Financial decisions prioritize long-term sustainability, accountability, and donor trust

## ■ Board Governance

- The Foundation is governed by a volunteer Board of Directors committed to strong oversight, transparency, and responsible stewardship.
- Day-to-day operations of the Foundation are managed by a volunteer Executive Director, allowing resources to remain focused on mission-related programs.

These meals are a small but meaningful way to recognize officers who spend holidays away from their families in service to the community. This program reflects donor support for officer morale, wellness, and appreciation.



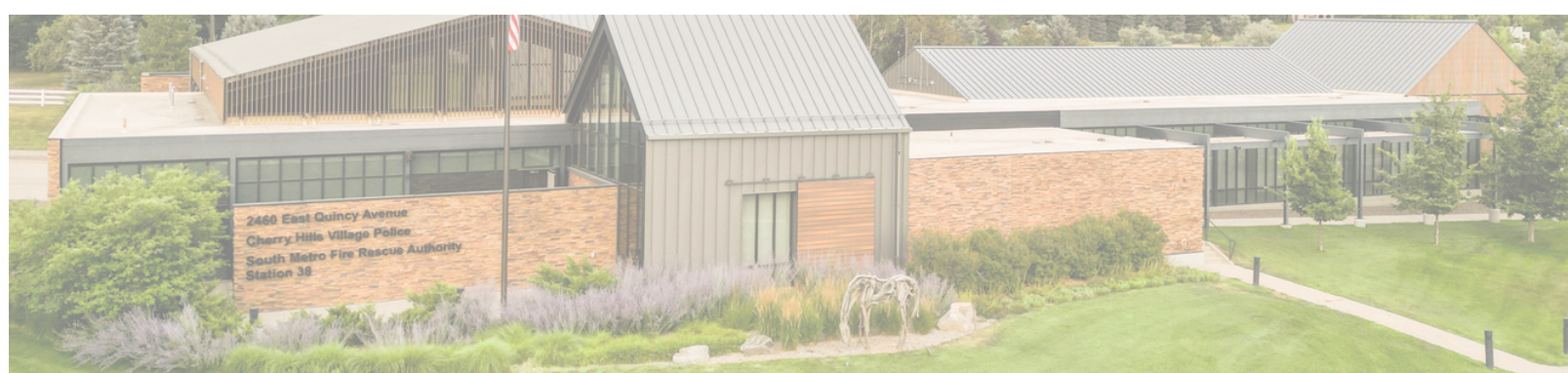
